

2012 HALL "Mount Veeder" Cabernet Sauvignon

97+ points – Another flirtatious example of near perfection is the 2012 Cabernet Sauvignon Mount Veeder. Pure blackberry and blueberry fruit mixed with white flowers and spice box are sensational in this opulent full-bodied, voluptuously textured wine. Deep, textured, rich, this is another tour de force from a winery that seems to be at the top of its game. Drink it over the next 20 years. —*Robert Parker, Wine Advocate*

2012 HALL "Segassia" Cabernet Sauvignon

90-93+ points – The 2012 Cabernet Sauvignon Segassia is the lightest, most floral and elegant of the 2012s as well as the least concentrated. Nevertheless, there is plenty of stuffing and flesh to this cuvee. It's reassuring to see one wine that's merely mortal, but still outstanding. —*Robert Parker, Wine Advocate*
